- Game of characters or roles: the teacher designs the roles, distributes to the students the role and the material to prepare the character and later it is staged.
- Provide material / elaboration of the tasks in this regard and sharing.
- Proposal of a problem / Bombardment of ideas / structuring of ideas / conclusions.
- Reciprocal teaching.
- Inverted class.

Assessment tasks inserted in the theoretical classes will be used mainly and located in such a way that they reinforce concepts, mean the conclusion of concepts, memory tasks and self-evaluation of previous knowledge.

All the activities will be adapted to the current situation, whether or not attendance is allowed; if this is not possible, audiovisual media, video and audio recordings will be used for classes and homework and videoconferences, using the platform that is best considered in each case: Moodle, Kahoot, Socrative and for communication e-mail and whatsapp.
