4.1. Methodological overview

The Undergraduate Dissertation consists of the defense of two cases pertaining to the clinical practice portfolio compiled during the course.

The work will materialize in a written description of two cases chosen by the student among those included in the portfolio of clinical practice and will be presented orally. In it, the student must demonstrate the ability to transmit the acquired knowledge and answer questions made by the committee.

The establishment of a proper diagnosis and treatment plan, presentation, clarity and understanding of writing, diversity and selection criteria of the information provided, the balance between information provided from external sources, organization and integration, the selection of complementary and optional activities, contributions of content, ideas or own suggestions will be evaluated.

In this process, the director / s will accompany and guide the student but the completion of the Final Degree Project involves fundamentally the autonomous work since it will be this one that will have to demonstrate a continuous ability to take creative and critical initiatives, to manage information and to express their knowledge in an appropriate way, always applying disciplinary integration, planning and organization of work.

4.2. Learning tasks

This course is organized as follows:

- **AUTONOMOUS WORK** of the student under the direction of the corresponding teacher/s.
- **Tutorials:** The director / s will guide the student and resolve any doubts that may arise during the preparation from work. Attendance to tutorials is recommended to support the development of the work and it is remembered that these form part of the assessment tests of the subject.

4.3. Syllabus

This is a transversal course that does not have own content and whose work will be done in association with different

courses.

4.4. Course planning and calendar
