RESOLUTION AND PRESENTATION OF PROBLEMS AND PRACTICAL CASES, elaboration and presentation of works, discussion of current events, comments on readings and iterative activities.

Tutorial and evaluation activities that allow a more direct and personal support for the students to supervise works, prepare and write reports, resolve doubts and guide them in their studies and in the solving of exercises. These tutorials may be individual or in groups.

The subject consists of 6 ECTS (150 hours). 30 hours will be devoted to theoretical classes and 30 hours will be devoted to practical cases, problems, etc. The remaining 90 hours correspond to autonomous work of the student
