Students should obtain the following results:

- Adapt, manage and make bibliographic searches suitable on a given theme using specialised data bases from the Social and Human Sciences field, like Pubmed, Scopus, Dialnet, etc.

- Objectively identify the standards of the quality and the scientific nature of scientific publications in education research by considering the journals' indexing processes and their evaluation/impact indices, such as CIRC, ERIH, JCR, Latindex, etc.

- Begin with scientific publication processes that match and fulfil publication guidelines.

- Write academic and/or research works, such as a Final Master Project (FMP) by considering a given structure and respecting a given level of specificity concerning content.

- Prepare oral presentations, like defending FMPs, that match the different normal formats in time, form and content terms

4.1.Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards achievement of the learning objectives. It is based on blended learning where theoretical-practical sessions will be accompanied by the autonomous work of subject-related materials provided by the teaching staff.

4.2.Learning tasks

The course includes 2 ECTS organized according to:

- Lectures: the professor presents theoretical-practical contents.
- Autonomous work: students do tasks such as autonomous study and preparation of an individual final assignment.
- Tutorials: professors' office hours can be used to solve doubts and to follow-up students' work.
- Assessment: individual final assignment evaluation with oral presentation of the work, and self-assessment.
